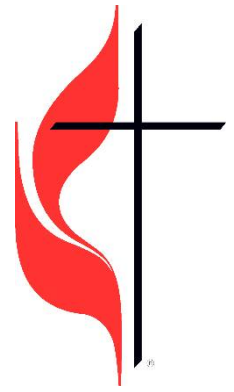

## LOVE GOD, LOVE OTHERS, REACH OUT

This is the vision statement of our church. We discerned it at our visioning retreat last February. Here is an update for you on the ways we continue to do this work. Sometimes if we don't hear about it, we don't know what's going on.

**LOVE GOD:** Our passionate worship of Jesus Christ continues. In September we baptized five people in one week! Bible studies and Huddles continue to help us strengthen our relationship with God. We have sent pilgrims on the Walk to Emmaus. LOGOS is teaching both kids and adults how to live as children of God. Our Youth Group is meeting regularly and the youth are learning how to follow Jesus when the world around them has a very different set of priorities.

**LOVE OTHERS:** Food Pantry is thriving, and the Free Store continues to serve hundreds of families every month. Crafty Ladies includes women from several different churches. Threads of Love gives baby blankets throughout the community.

**REACH OUT:** We now have Christian addiction recovery groups for men and women! The women's group is called Sisterhood and it meets on the second and fourth Fridays of the month at 10 AM in the Community Building. The men's group is called RIFF (Recovery in Faith and Fellowship) and it meets every Friday at 7 PM in the Community Building. Additionally, we are providing Peralta Elementary School students with food to take home and sending notes of encouragement to teachers and staff. We hope to build a robust relationship of loving and caring with the students and especially the staff at the school. We also can't forget the wonderful work of our church at the Men's and Women's Recovery Academies, providing art therapy, Christian recovery classes, and the way our trustees mentor men from the Men's Recovery Academy who come and do amazing construction and maintenance work at our church almost every Saturday.

As you can see, we are living into our vision statement in many ways. Is the Holy Spirit calling you to Love God, Love Others, or Reach Out? Is there something on your heart, something that God says is the right thing to do, or something that God says, "Do this now?" If so, come and talk with me.

I can't wait for our February visioning retreat, when we meet together, share how we have lived into our vision statement, and dream about God's plan for our church in 2019 and beyond. Truly, Peralta Memorial UMC is a place where the Kingdom of God and God's love are made real, tangible, and a force in our community and world.

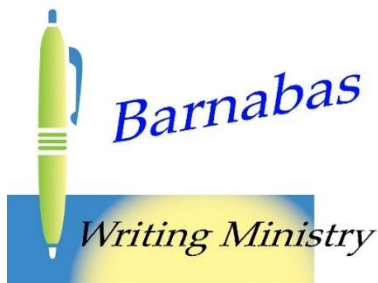
Everyone is encouraged to join the Ministry leaders at this once-a-year meeting, to hear about the good work being done for God's Kingdom.
