Going Beyond Our Walls to Build God's Kingdom

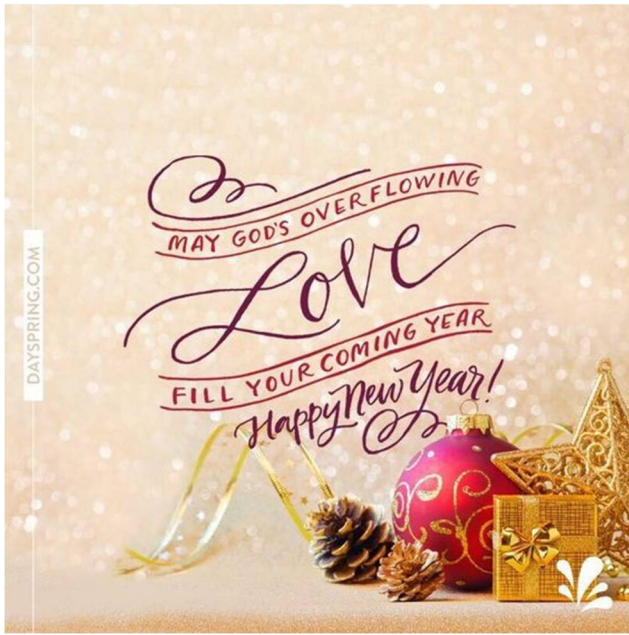
