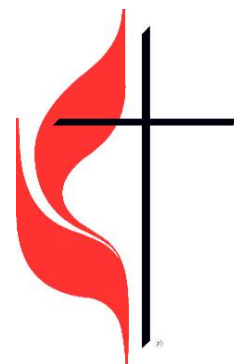

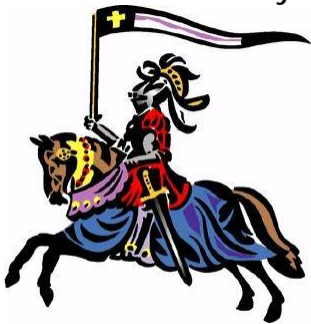

Praying 2022 will be good for us all – and AfterShock Youth want to say THANK YOU!!!! one and all... for your support.

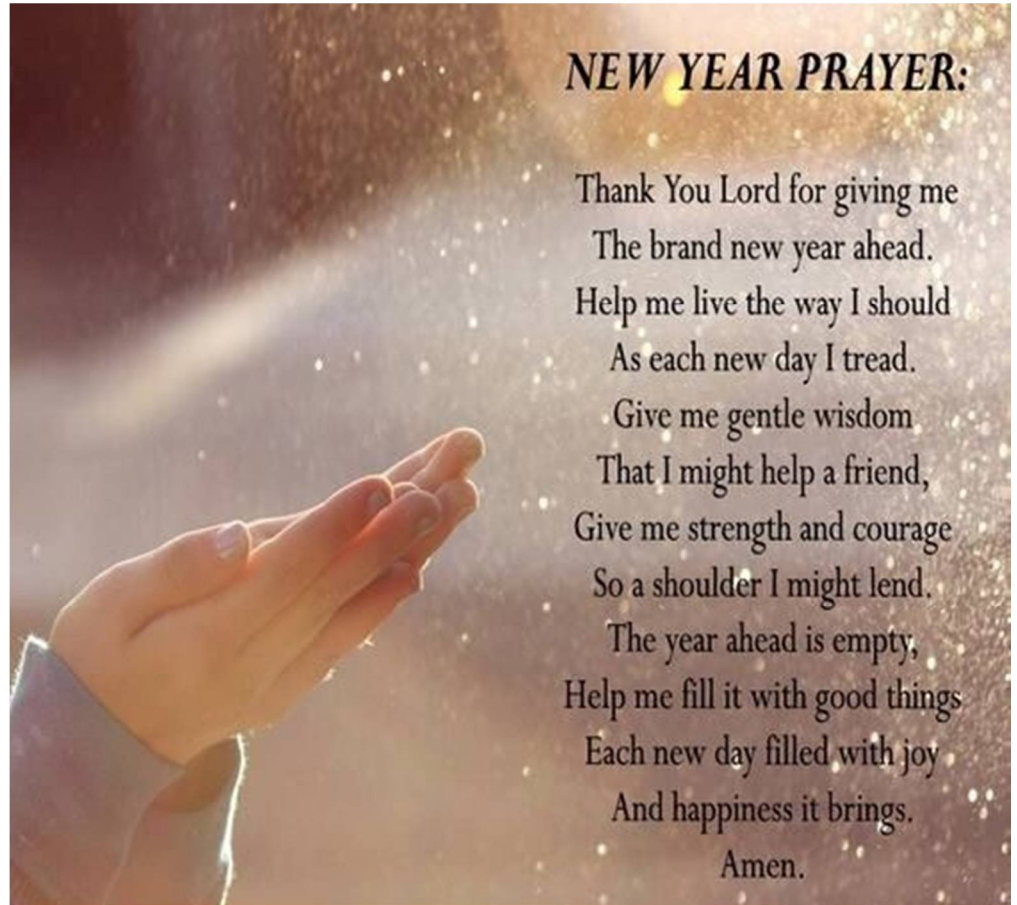
Undeck the Halls
