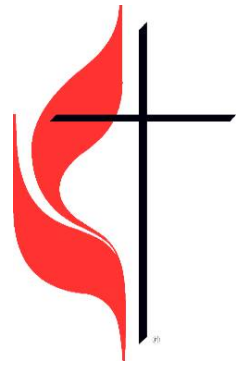

This will be an extended meeting. In addition to prayers and devotion, we will be making sports-emblem jewelry items to sell along with the bake sale on August 14th



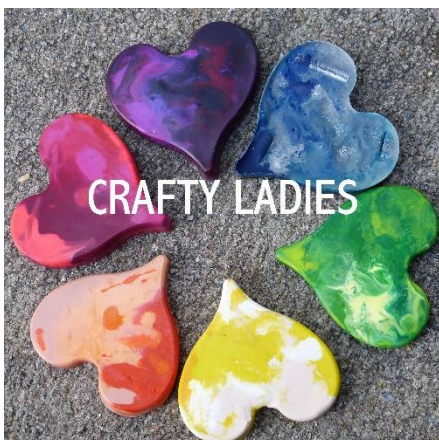
