Pastor's Message

May I speak a word for the *memories* giving rise to Memorial Day? Have you considered how often holy obedience, personal morality and common decency turns out to be a function of memory?

If your family of origin is like mine, parents sternly warned you of dire consequences for outbreaks of childish misbehavior when visiting relatives or friends. No, they explained, no offspring of ours will be allowed to act like ill-mannered, marauding mongol while being a guest in someone else's home. Why? That's not who you are, they would remind me.

I don't think I could have been any older than six or seven years of age when it first dawned on my forgetful backside that *knowing how to behave is usually an act of faithful remembering*. In those early days my father was adept at applying life lessons that left an impression, if you get my meaning.

I'm older now, but the basic dynamic is unchanged. Doing the right thing is an imaginative act, and most of the obedience I can imagine turns out to be rooted in memories. I want to be like the wise and holy people who have graced my life. So we pause to recall the toil and sacrifice of those who went before us, and our lives are shaped by their grateful remembering. We don't originate holiness. Memorial Day simply reminds us of saints worth remembering. Christian Historian Jaroslav Pelkan puts it memorably:

Early in the morning, Friday, we set out from the church and followed Grant Irwin who led us down the ditch banks all the way to the hill.
