Going Beyond Our Walls to Build God's Kingdom

Pastor's Message

"Morning and morning the Lord wakens my ear to listen - Isaiah 50:4"

Although the list of the original, standard equipment that comes with the model that is me did not include *earlids*, my ability to turn a deaf ear to messages of importance can be breathtaking. Presumably, I am not alone in this. The perceptive novelist known as George Eliot sarcastically observed that perhaps it is necessary that we should grow dull and inattentive rather than being driven mad by being able to hear the growing of grass and the beating of squirrel hearts. But, she wrote, most of us are already so well-wadded with stupidity that we will manage to miss all but the most obvious points without much difficulty. This may prove to be a helpful explanation of governmental gridlock, intractable hostility in the Middle-East, and even befuddled husbands who will not stop at the gas station to ask for directions. We don't listen very well. The essential human condition turns out to be that we tend to stumble along while living as if we are hearingimpaired.

Biblical faith offers an alternative. Morning by morning, the prophet Isaiah recounted, the Lord opened my ear. Literally, the prophet was suggesting that listening to God is a process in which some elective surgery is performed by a divine hand. God is *digging out* our ears, applying a scalpel edge to open a new channel for receptive listening. It may be a way of saying that listening carefully to God may be very painful. Or it may be a way of saying that we only tend to listen carefully when we are in pain. But what seems clear from the image Isaiah uses is that God is not at all squeamish about cutting away absolutely anything that makes us insensitive and unresponsive to the words we should be hearing.

So when we gather again for worship we let Jesus tell us stuff that we would rather not hear. Let me simply tell you that it may be costly. Frequently it will be painful. And of course, *having your earlids removed is no guarantee that your life will turn out to be easy.* So forgive us poor preachers for suggesting at times that if you choose to make Jesus your choice you will drive a Mercedes. He will do even better than that if you will submit to the full treatment: Jesus can make you into a Disciple!


