#### Going Beyond Our Walls to Build God's Kingdom

#### Pastor's Message

It always seems a challenge to keep a focus on thanksgiving at Thanksgiving! There's food to prepare, football games on the TV, children running around and a dog or two also. And each year there's some adversity somewhere in the family, a death, illness, surgery or other challenge. It would be very easy to quickly offer the requisite mealtime blessing (or even skip it) and dig in to our meal. I'd like to encourage you to pause, and help your family pause, to give thanks tomorrow. I encourage you to pause five times a day to give thanks (when you awaken, before each meal and at bedtime). And at your mealtime, consider inviting each person to write down or share something they are grateful for, or give them fifteen seconds of silence in your mealtime prayer encouraging them to give thanks in silence.

Psalm 100 is one of many Psalms of Thanksgiving and could be read before your meal:

Shout triumphantly to the Lord, all the earth! Serve the Lord with celebration!

Come before him with shouts of joy!

Know that the Lord is God — he made us; we belong to him.

We are his people, the sheep of his own pasture.

Enter his gates with thanks; enter his courtyards with praise!

Thank him! Bless his name!

Because the Lord is good, his loyal love lasts forever;

his faithfulness lasts generation after generation.

If you are looking for a meaningful Thanksgiving Day meal blessing, here is an excellent one. Lord God.

Our hearts are crowded with gratitude

as we celebrate the feast of Thanksgiving.

We have come to this our feasting table with great joy and eagerness,

for we are truly grateful to you, our God,

for all that we have been given.

We pause now and, in silent prayer,

do thank you for the great generosity of Your gifts.

We also thank one another for gifts -


especially for the gifts of love and affection that we have freely shared.


We hope that anyone who is coping with a loss will come and be a part of this caring group of people, who are here to support one another.


