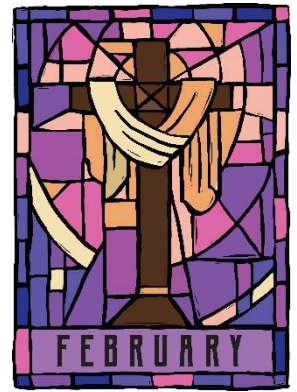

Going Beyond Our Walls to Build God's Kingdom

Before anything else, the Christian church worships. That is the church's main business. In response to God's mighty and gracious acts – proclaimed anew in preaching and sacraments – the gathered church praises, thanks, and adores God. The church confesses sin, humbly asks for pardon, and then receives God's assurance of forgiveness. The church brings prayerful petitions and expresses faith that God will hear them.

To worship, as the Bible sees it, is to give yourself up, body and soul to another. You present yourself, prostrate yourself, lay yourself out before someone else offering that person all that you are and all that you have. You do this from a conviction that the other person deserves such unconditional surrender and that it's therefore fitting for you to offer it. Bowing and kneeling are the age old emblems of this surrender.

"O come, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker! For he is our God." Psalm 95:6-7.

Answering this call to worship is counter cultural because contemporary culture thinks its humiliating to surrender to God. To worship God, to confess our failures and assign life's blessings to God, to praise and thank God – to take this posture is so oppressive. Sadly, some Christians have also become uneasy. In our consumer driven society, churches sometimes convert Christian worship into an hour that focuses not on God but on us and on what makes us feel good.

To the writers of Scripture, the beginning of wisdom – and the beginning of worship – is the fear of the Lord. The fear of the Lord is a mixture of awe and love. That is why God fearing people not only exult in the Lord, but also bow down before him.

***Give us, O Lord, humility to accept your greatness,
awe to acknowledge your holiness, and
gratitude to adore your goodness,
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.***

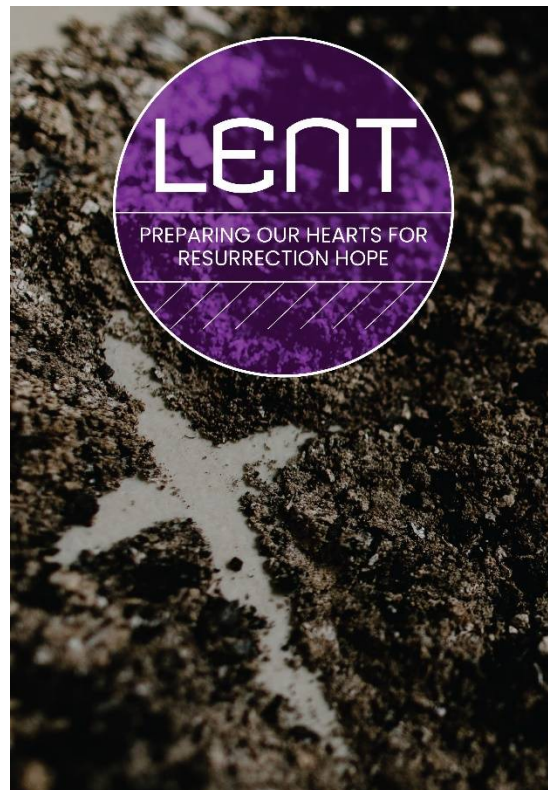

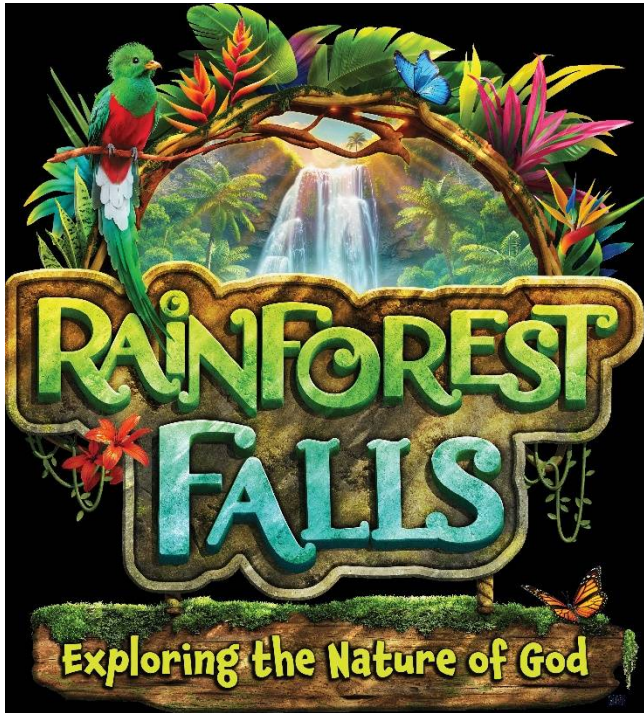
